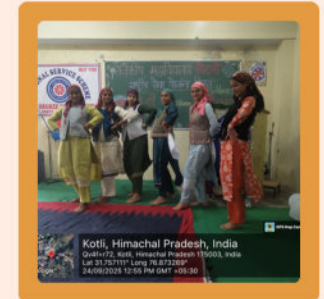

FORMATION OF PARENT-TEACHER ASSOCIATION (PTA) IN COLLEGE



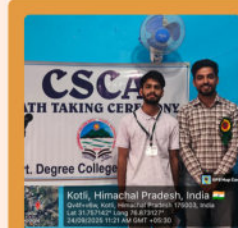
